

Wall Quilt



Quilt Squares, many patterns and colors depending on theme of quilt

Craft or tacky glue

Masking or duct tape

Cardstock or other thin cardboard, squares or rectangles

Embellishments: ribbon, buttons, pipe cleaner, etc.

Ribbon for border and seams

-Glue fabric onto multiple pieces of cardstock with thin layer of glue, let dry

-Cut out stencils of multiple objects or shapes pertaining to theme (ex. "spring" – umbrellas, ducks, rain drops, flowers, leaves, etc.)

-Reserve whole squares of fabric'd cardstock for base (about 9-16 pieces); with other pieces, trace stencils on back and cut out

-Have residents experiment with placing different color combinations and positions of shapes onto the base of their choice. When layout is decided upon, glue onto base.

-When all squares are dry, arrange in desired position and tape backs together.

-Turn over and glue ribbon to border and seams.
